Article VIII, Section 3.a. of the MSEA Bylaws states, "Local affiliates of the Association shall be allotted delegate credentials on the basis of one (1) for each fifty (50) or major fraction thereof of Active Emeritus members of MSEA within the affiliate as of June 30 of the preceding membership year."

Article XI, Section 1.d of the WCTA Bylaws states, "The President shall serve as delegate and chairperson of the delegations to MSEA and NEA conventions, the MSEA General Council..." Locals are entitled to one delegate for each 150 members or major fraction thereof who is Active, Life, or Educational Support members of the NEA.
